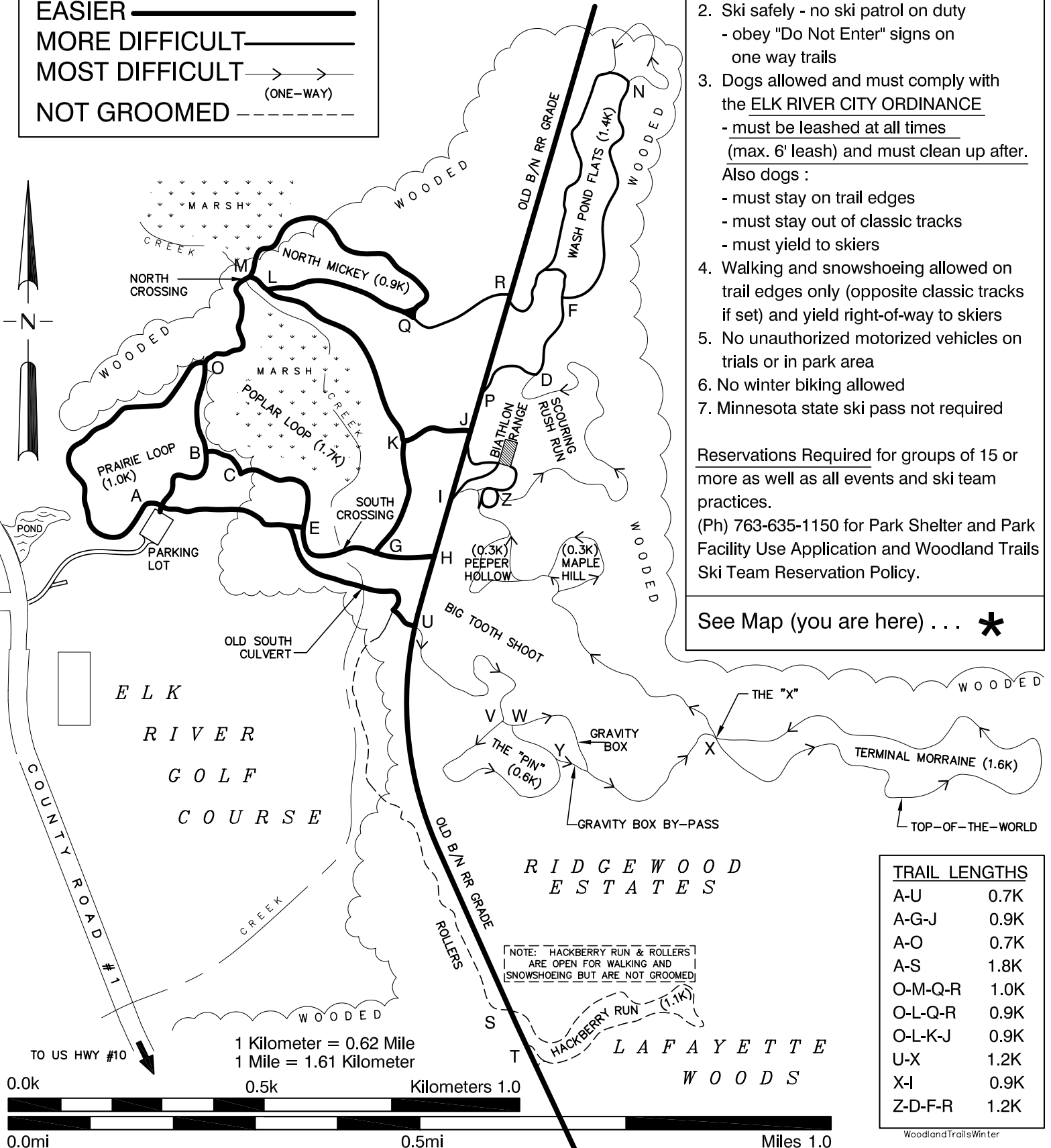

TRAIL RULES

- Ski on groomed trails only.
- Ski safely - no ski patrol on duty
- obey "Do Not Enter" signs on one way trails
- Dogs allowed and must comply with the ELK RIVER CITY ORDINANCE
- must be leashed at all times (max. 6' leash) and must clean up after.
Also dogs :
- must stay on trail edges
- must stay out of classic tracks
- must yield to skiers
- Walking and snowshoeing allowed on trail edges only (opposite classic tracks if set) and yield right-of-way to skiers
- No unauthorized motorized vehicles on trails or in park area
- No winter biking allowed
- Minnesota state ski pass not required
